Chemical Industries Council of Malaysia (CICM) Announces the Commencement of the Responsible Care Awards 2017 / 2018 & CICM Safe Road Award 2018

Petaling Jaya, Selangor (May 15, 2018) ó Ir Haji Dasuki bin Mohd Haek, Director of Petroleum Safety Division of the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) officiated a launch at the Hilton Petaling Jaya today; marking the commencement of the CICM Responsible Care Awards 2017 / 2018 & CICM Safe Road Award 2018.

The Responsible Care Awards, which is organized by CICM, was first introduced in 2002. Now into its 15th year, the Awards aim to promote greater awareness of the Responsible Care Programme (RCP) and its principles, giving recognition to Responsible Care signatories that have made the most progress in implementing the Responsible Care's Six Codes of Management Practices in their organizations. The main categories of the Awards 2017 / 2018 are the Corporate Awards for the Six Codes of Management Practices, Special Awards for the SMEs and the Responsible Care Leadership Award.

In addition, CICM will continue with its Safe Road Award 2018 to recognize chemical transporters with good safety governance and compliance to legislative requirements. It also complements the objectives of Responsible Care. The Safe Road Award is opened to CICM members / Responsible Care signatories who manage their own transport operations or their main transport contractors.

This year, the CICM Responsible Care Awards 2017 / 2018 and CICM Safe Road Award 2018 is sponsored by Lotte Chemical Titan Holding Bhd, one of our Responsible Care signatories in Malaysia. Established in 1991, the company is Malaysia's first standalone producer of polyolefins and Malaysia's largest integrated producer of olefins and polyolefins and one of the largest polyolefins producer in Southeast Asia. It is one of the leading petrochemical companies in Malaysia.

Responsible Care is a voluntary initiative of the global chemical industry. It was initiated in Canada in 1985 and has since been adopted by 66 countries worldwide, with the aim to continuously improve practices in the areas of health, safety and environment. Responsible Care is one of the CICM's flagship activities; with the same aim to continuously improve the safety, health and environment performance of the chemical industry in Malaysia, through self-regulation. Since the launch of Responsible Care in 1994 in Malaysia, more than 130 chemical companies in the country have pledged to manage their operations according to the 10 Guiding Principles and the 6 Codes of Management Practices of the RCP.
